**Keep a distance of 10 feet between your vehicle and the one next to you!**

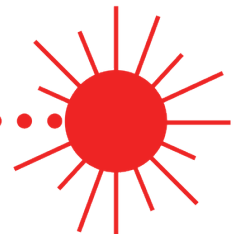


## CAUTION

**ecomaine uses lasers to mark its lanes**

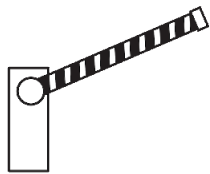
**DO NOT LOOK INTO THE BEAM**

**AND STAY IN YOUR LANE**



**1. Stop at the entrance to the Tipping Hall. Do not enter until the operator gives you permission. Do not block the two-way traffic from either direction.**

**Wait for the automated arm to lift.**



**2. Stay within four feet of your vehicle - never cross the tipping hall without the operator's permission.**

**3. Motion to the operator if you need assistance - make sure you have their attention before approaching.**

**4. No children are allowed out of the vehicle.**



**5. Only one person should exit the vehicle unless another is needed to unload. Please unload in a timely manner.**

**6. Wear shoes with good traction soles and safety glasses.**



**7. ecomaine recommends hi-visibility clothing and gloves for hand protection.**



**8. Hearing protection is recommended. Ask the Scale House Attendant if you would like some.**

**9. Stay a minimum of six feet away from the trash bay openings and chutes.**

**10. Keep ten feet of distance between your vehicle and the one next to you.**

**11. No alcohol or smoking is permitted on site.**



**12. Be vigilant to other traffic in the area where you are dumping. Be aware when large trucks are dumping next to you - unstable loads may create rolling debris hazards in your area.**

**13. In the event of a fire alarm or emergency, finish unloading and exit in an orderly manner, following the attendant's instructions.**

**14. Maintain appropriate speeds at all times, especially while entering or exiting the tipping halls at the Recycling and the Waste-to-Energy plants. Observe all stop signs.**



**16. Blowing litter of any kind is not acceptable. Please make sure your loads are covered when entering or exiting ecomaine's facilities.**

**17. Liquid leakage on roads and driveways is not acceptable. If a leak occurs, a driver must obtain Speedy Dri from the tipping hall to contain the spill right away. Promptly notify the attendant.**

**18. ecomaine is not licensed to accept hazardous waste of any kind. If you spot suspicious waste in your load, please promptly notify the scale house or tipping hall attendants.**

**19. ecomaine is pleased to do its part to divert food waste from landfills through our organic waste bunker. At times, there may be odors in the tipping hall as a result. Occasionally, there may be wait times as this material is loaded for transport.**
