SUBJECT: Outreach & Recycling Committee Minutes – May 25, 2023

The **ecomaine** Outreach & Recycling Committee met May 25th. The meeting was called to order at 4:05 p.m. by Caleb Hemphill, Chairman.

- 1. Approval of Minutes
 - Rob Wood moved to approve April 13th's minutes; Linda Boudreau seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.
- 2. CEO Kevin Roche opened the meeting sharing information about ecomaine's upcoming annual meeting and our guest speaker, Michael Hoffman, a financial analyst in the solid waste industry. Kevin also gave an update to the progress made on the acquisition of 90 Blueberry Rd. in Portland, ME. Kevin also shared Matt Grondin's departure of ecomaine effective June 2nd, 2023. Kevin concluded by noting that Nate Cronauer has been appointed Acting Communications Manager in the interim.
- 3. Review and approval of final payments for ecomaine's 'FY22-23 School Waste Diversion Grant' submissions-
 - The committee approved a "no-cost extension" for Fiddlehead School in Gray, ME to reallocate funds received due to the inability to secure construction of a concrete dumpster pad. An updated submission was received to be approved by the committee.
 - The committee recognized and approved that Lyseth Elementary in Portland, ME would not receive the final 20% of their grant because a final report was not received.
 - Caleb H. motioned to close out 'FY22-23 School Waste Diversion Grant.' Dave Durrell seconded.
- 4. Review and Approval of 'FY23-24 School Waste Diversion Grant' submissions -
 - The committee decided to have Nate reach back out to H.B. Emery school to have them reevaluate their grant and bring down to hard cost, issues of cost to waste hauling and replicability of the grant were mentioned.
 - The committee decided to have Nate reach back out to Readfield Elementary School to receive more information on expenses of the grant, the committee did not want to disapprove, but needs more info.
 - Linda Boudreau suggested working with the educators in the grant process moving forward to have them conduct waste audits to assess the grant applicants' successes and challenges of their projects.

- The committee approved \$11,324 of the total \$25,000 to be distributed to their respective schools. Several submissions were not approved due to being too vague, not aligning enough with waste diversion, or was not replicable enough in nature once established.
- 5. FY23 P.R. & Outreach Metrics Nate Cronauer provided a look at FY23's metrics to date.
- 6. Program updates staff provided updates on the progress of the following:
 - ecomaine Annual Meeting June 15th, 2023
 - Nate shared updates on the hiring of Abigail Hart as "Social Media and Marketing Specialist" and Bea Johnson as "Environmental Educator"
- 7. Recycling Market Report: Nate Cronauer presented the handout of recycling markets/pricing.
- 8. Other Business: The Committee recognized the service at ecomaine of Matt Grondin, who will be departing after June 2nd, 2023.

Caleb Hemphill made the motion to adjourn at 5:13 p.m. Linda Boudreau seconded.



Manager's Report – Communications & Education Communications, Public Relations, & Education Accomplishments for October 2023

P.R. & Community Outreach...

- Through FY24 we reached **11,389** people through in-person outreach. In October of FY24 we reached **1502** people.
 - FY23 at this point was at [19,599] reached. FY22 was [31,057].
- ecomaine has offered the position of "Curbside Education Staff" to Adam Clair, a
 Mainer and graduate from Texas State University with a BA in Economics. He
 has accepted our offer and his paperwork is processing now. He brings with him
 skills in outreach and data analysis which will lend well to this role. He starts
 November 27th. We will continue to accept applications for our third intern
 position.
- ecomaine will continue its' partnership with the Maine Celtics engaging in tabling during 6 game days, with one on court promotion, and the continuation of the Crusher program. We also are continuing our partnership with the Maine Mariners participating in 7 on ice promos and 4 concourse tabling events. This allows a venue to share messaging with thousands of Mainers. These events begin on December 1st, 2024.
- We will be announcing our call for the 2024 eco-excellence award nominations on November 10th and will close on January 17th, 2024. Please consider nominating members of your communities who have exemplified great work in waste reduction, conservation, and sustainability.
- ecomaine has placed an increased focus on our digital outreach this year
 producing educational videos, sustainable community member interviews, "Daily
 Trash Talk" polls, promotion of our events and programming, and much more!
 Through digital outreach we reached 14,040 people in October, for a total of
 32,290 in FY24.
- We have been marketing through radio, television, and print in areas where
 ecomaine could accept more recyclable material in anticipation for the new
 recycling center. We have reviewed demographic and psychographic data to
 best target potential communities in the mid-coast and central Maine.
- The Outreach & Recycling Committee awarded \$16,846.06 for the School Recycling and Waste Diversion Grants for 2023. Updates from schools will be

provided in December and shared with the committee at the following Outreach and Recycling meeting.

- In October, the Recyclopedia saw **4,332** items searched. The total number of items searched over the lifespan of the database is **1,759,011**.
- The total widget views to date on web pages was viewed 538,508 times in October on ecomaine's site and others who have embedded it.
- Total app downloads to date stand at **5,663** (an increase of 26)
- The top 10 searches are: Styrofoam, mattresses, almond milk cartons, air conditioners, electronics, textiles, electronic lawnmowers, single-use batteries, baby formula cans, tires


Total web traffic for October was 3,135 visits. This shows a decrease of 13% from 3587 visits in September. This is down 23% compared to 4076 visits in October 2022.


Social Media Stats:






